A thirty kilometer grid search of reported incident location reveals no aircraft losses in 1974 in this area. The last reported loss in this area was almost 2 yrs. earlier in 1972. Because of the vast differences in the dates, no correlation can be made.

2. Summary: Source provided limited hearsay information concerning alleged U.S. remains buried off the coast of Do Son (XH9692).


3. Information: Source said that sometime in 1987 his mother, NAME informed him about a grave of a U.S. pilot located on an island (XH9692), off the coast of Do Son. Source heard that an American jet plane was shot down and crashed in the ocean off Do Son in 1967. The pilot was found in the water and brought to shore where he died from injuries. Source heard the pilot was white and had a broken arm and leg. The pilot was buried on the beach. Source does not know the exact location of the grave. Source heard that the authorities were not notified of the pilots burial. Source heard that in 1983 or 1984 a

Vietnamese investigative team tried to locate the grave. The team dug in a few areas but did not locate the grave site.

4. When RO inquired information on source's mother, source refused to answer and just said he was afraid of causing his mother trouble because of what he had said.
