1. Source/administrative data:

2. Summary: Source claims to have witnessed the crash of an F-5 aircraft in Duc Hoa (D), Hau Nghia (now Long An), XT 523018. He does not know if the aircraft were USAF or VNAF, and does not know the fate of the pilot.

3. Information: One evening in the rainy season of 1967 Source was on an operation with his unit in Bao Cua (H), Duc Hoa (D), Hau Nghia (P). At about 1900 he saw an F-5 aircraft shot down by VC fire and crash into dense growth about 500 meters from his position, where it exploded and burned. He estimates the crash site to be located at XT 523018. He saw no parachute emerge from the aircraft. The vehicles of his unit were bogged down in the mud, and so not until the next day did they get to the site.

4. Source remembers no information from the aircraft wreckage. He saw no trace of remains at the site, but did

recover a wristwatch, which he has long since misplaced. He heard no subsequent information about the fate of the pilot.

Subj: REMAINS AND A DOG TAG FOUND AND REBURIED IN SONG BE PROVINCE

1. Source/administrative data:

2. Summary: Source claims to have uncovered three remains and an American dog tag while on a work detail in the Tong Le Chan "re-education" camp, Song Be Province (XT 625816). The cadre assigned to supervise the detail told Source to wrap the remains and dog tag and rebury them.

3. Information: In March, 1979 Source was an inmate in section K-1 of the Tong Le Chan "re-education" camp, Song Be Province. One afternoon he was part of a five-man work team excavating a pit for a fish pond just north of the eastern end of the steel bridge spanning the Saigon River (XT 625816). As the team dug they uncovered three metal crosses, at the foot of which lay three remains. Fragments of ARVN ranger uniforms were mixed with two of the remains, while the third, which included bones
