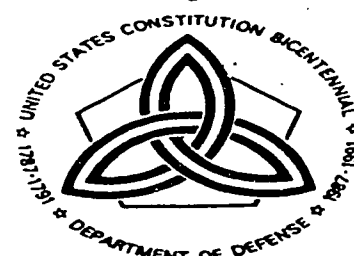

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: COLLECTION OPPORTUNITY - PW/MIA

1. Reference: 1. MEMORANDUM FOR: Commander, DET 0, IAGPC-D-OV/ST, 17 Nov 1989, SAB. 2. DIA message, DAM-1, DTG: 141300Z Nov 89, SAB.

2. On 11 December 1989, *NAME*, Retired U.S. Postal Worker, *DATA* was interviewed at his residence. *NAME* stated substantially as follows:

NAME was able to identify the individual in the photograph as HIS daughter *NAME* of *DATA* telephone number *DATA*. *NAME* stated that HIS daughter had been in the U.S. Army and stationed in Thailand, location, unit of assignment and dates not recalled. *NAME* could provide no information as to whom Annie was or the meaning of the message on the photograph. Other than HIS daughter *NAME* had no relatives who served in the armed forces. *NAME* could not provide any additional information.

3. 19 December 1989, *NAME*, SSN: *DATA*, U.S. Postal Service, was interviewed in HER residence at *DATA*. *NAME* stated substantially as follows:

NAME had been station at Field Station Ramason, Udon, Thailand as an E4, O5D, Direction Finding Specialist, with the 7th Radio Research Company, U.S. Army Security Agency from June 1974 to June 1975. During that time *NAME* become friendly with a Thai national who worked at the Ramason NCO Club and was known as "Annie" by American service personnel. Annie's Thai name was FNU [*NAME*]. *NAME* saw Annie whenever SHE went to the NCO Club and gave Annie a copy of a photograph with the message in question before SHE rotated from Thailand to the U.S. in June 1975. *NAME* had received no communication from Annie since leaving Thailand. SHE could provide no information concerning Annie's full name, address, or current location. *NAME* was cooperative during the interview and provided a copy of a photograph of *NAME* (AKA Annie).
