Dear Ms. Lasiter:

An additional \$20 filing fee was submitted for each of the above mentioned Statement of Accounts. Three of the Statements have gross receipts under \$137,100, which means those are considered SA-1's. These statements require a \$52 royalty fee and a \$15 filing fee, totaling \$67 per statement. The final statement which has gross receipts over \$137,100 is considered an SA-2. The royalty fee calculated for this statement was \$54.50 plus the \$20 filing fee, totaling \$74.50. The total submitted was \$355.50 as opposed to what I determined should have been \$275.50.

Please review. If you agree with our findings, it seems this error has resulted in an overpayment of \$20 per statement, totaling \$80. The attached EFT form should be completed and accompany your response, if you determine a refund is due. Please e-mail your response to expedite this process. You may contact me with any questions pertaining to this matter.

I am authorizing Community Communications an \$80 refund of royalties. This refund is the result of an overpayment of the royalty fee in the amount of \$20 for each of the above mentioned statements. The refund will be forwarded to the account that you identified to this Office.
