It appears educational station KSMQ and KTCA were reported distant in part 9 in the DSE schedule but not reported distant in Space G or part 2. Please review.

Next, New Licensing Division Fees Effective March 20, 2020.

The Copyright Office has adopted a new fee schedule, beginning March 20, 2020, that affects fees throughout the Office, including the Licensing Division (see the Federal Register, 85 FR 9374). The fee changes affect cable, satellite, and DART filers as well as those seeking section 112 and 114 licenses.

For amended statements of account filed by cable and satellite systems and digital audio recording device (DART) importers/manufacturers, the fee has been reduced to \$50; however, it is important to note that the Office intends to charge that amendment fee in a wider range of circumstances. For information on the new fees for Division services, see Circular 76. This fee is due for any material changes. The submission of a Statement of Account lacking the required information or fees may jeopardize the validity of your statutory license, and your secondary transmission activity may be subject to full liability under the copyright act. Without a statutory license, a cable system could be sued by copyright owners for the full range of civil remedies for copyright infringement, including injunctions, actual damages and profits, or statutory damages (of up to \$150,000 in cases of willful infringement). The statute also provides for criminal penalties in cases of willful infringement for commercial purposes.
