Ah, looks like I missed some important pieces of that. I also got thrown off by section E mentioning to report that the facts we state must be those existing on the last day of the accounting period. So

to answer your original question properly, for our 2022-2 report (using July 31, 2022 billings) we had:

- Residential – Service to first set – 72; with the rate being \$77 per month
- Residential – Service to additional sets – 111; with the rate being \$7 per additional set

I've got the EFT remittance advice form downloaded and ready to send over to you and the licfiscal@loc.gov email address. I'll have to look back through my notes on sending the payment to you all through pay.gov after I send this EFT advice to you.

Do I need to submit an amended SA 1-2E and cover letter about our ceased operations to you?

Brad,

Thank-you for your reply. Please see below for an excerpt taken from the instructions of the Statement of Account.

“If your cable system completely shut down operations during the accounting period, report the facts as they existed on the last day of operations and submit the SOA with the associated royalty and filing fee payments and a cover letter informing the Licensing Section of ceased operations. If your cable system had no subscribers or gross receipts during the entire accounting period, do not submit the SOA or any fees. You do not need to notify us in this case”.

Since, you stated your system shut down as of July 31st, Space E should reflect the information that existed on the last day of operation.

Also, please keep in mind that effective March 20, 2020 there is a \$50 amendment fee for any and all material changes. Additional information on this fee can be found on our website at www.copyright.gov/licensing. A copy of the Licensing Division Electronic Funds Transfer Remittance Advice form, which can also be obtained on our website, should be completed and e-mailed to me and licfiscal@loc.gov prior to any EFT.

We reported 0 subscribers due to SPTC Telcom ceasing the IPTV / cable service as of July 31, 2022. We only had 1 month of revenue / services for the 2nd half of 2022. This is why we had a significant decrease in subscribers and revenue for that accounting period and also the reason why I haven't filed an SA1 for accounting period 2023-1. When I was reading through the SA1 instructions it mentioned that we didn't need to notify the Copyright Office that we have ceased operations, so I followed that. Sorry for any confusion this may have caused.
