The above referenced cable system has appeared to have overpaid its royalty for the Statement of Account submitted for the 1999/2 accounting period. The overpayment occurred because the incorrect Statement of Account form (SA 3) for systems with semi-annual gross receipts over \$527,600 was used instead of the SA1-2 Short form in determining the royalty fee.

Please review this matter, and return your response, together with a copy of this letter. Once this office has received your response, an overpayment of any kind will be considered upon examination.
