Dear Mr. Newton:

We've reviewed the Statement of Account filed for system no. 014054 (Kingwood) and agree with the Copyright Office's determination that, because the reported gross receipts for that system did not exceed the \$527,000 cut-off for short-form filings, it should have been filed on an SA 1-2 short form rather than the long-form SA3. This also means that the Kingwood system is exempt from the minimum fee applicable to systems with higher revenues. Therefore, instead of the \$5,549.54 fee that Atlantic Broadband paid for the Kingwood system under those minimum-fee rules, it should have paid the lesser amount of \$3,896.73—a difference of \$1,652.81.

Attached please find a revised Statement of Account and a completed EFT form. Please let us know if you need any additional information.

The above referenced cable system has appeared to have overpaid its royalty for the Statement of Account submitted for the 1999/2 accounting period. The overpayment occurred because the incorrect Statement of Account form (SA 3) for systems with semi-annual gross receipts over \$527,600 was used instead of the SA1-2 Short form in determining the royalty fee.

Please review this matter, and return your response, together with a copy of this letter. I have attached a blank form SA1-2 Short form for your completion and a photocopy of your SA3 Statement of Account filing your referral. Once this office has received your response, an overpayment of any kind will be considered upon examination.
