Dear Ms. Brown:

A refund in the amount of \$1,632.70 has been authorized on behalf of the above referenced cable system. The refund is due to the cable system submitting their statement of account on the incorrect form type which resulted in an overpayment of the royalty due.

The Library of Congress is adopting a federal best practice by transferring its payment processes to the U.S. Treasury. As of April 3rd, the U.S. Treasury began issuing all checks and electronic funds transfer (EFT) payments on behalf of the Library. As a result of this change the U.S. Treasury may subject some payments to reductions under the Treasury Offset Program, through which the Treasury collects delinquent debt owed to federal and state agencies.
