In Part 9 of the above referenced Statement of Account, it seems multicast broadcast stations WCVE - 2 and WCVE-3 were reported distant and nonpermitted. The FCC deems all multicast signals permitted. Please review.

Without a statutory license, a cable system could be sued by copyright owners for the full range of civil remedies for copyright infringement, including injunctions, actual damages and profits, or statutory damages (of up to \$150,000 in cases of willful infringement). The statute also provides for criminal penalties in cases of willful infringement for commercial purposes.
