FINDING OF DEATH

Lieutenant Commander Erwin Benard **TEMPLIN, Jr., USN,** DATA
was reported missing in action 22 January 1966. Pursuant to the provisions of the Missing Persons Act (37 USCA 555) and the delegated authority of the Secretary of the Navy, the Director, Personal Services Division of the Bureau of Naval Personnel, this 10th day of May 1973, finds that Lieutenant Commander Erwin Renard Templin, Jr. was killed in action, having died when his aircraft was lost over North Vietnam.

In compliance with Section 555 of the Missing Persons Act (37 USCA), death is presumed to have occurred on 10 May 1973.
