SUBJ: INTERVIEW WITH LTC (RET) OLEG MIKHAILOVICH ALEKSANDROV

1. BACKGROUND: ON 26 APRIL 2000, JCSD-WASHINGTON REPRESENTATIVES, MR. ROGER SCHUMACHER AND TSGT THOMAS SHIPP, CONDUCTED AN INTERVIEW WITH LTC (RET) OLEG MIKHAILOVICH ALEKSANDROV OF REISTERSTOWN, MARYLAND (JCSD NOTE: ALEKSANDROV IMMIGRATED IN 1994 AND BECAME A US CITIZEN IN JANUARY 2000). ALEKSANDROV WAS TEMPORARILY ASSIGNED TO NORTH VIETNAM ON FOUR SEPARATE OCCASIONS (JCSD NOTE: FALL OF 1966, AT AN OLD FRENCH CASERNE IN HA DONG; JUL-NOV 1967, VILLAGE IN VINH PHU PROVINCE LOCATED ABOUT AN HOUR FROM HANOI; FALL OF 1968, KIM LIEN, A VILLAGE LOCATED ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF HANOI; NOV 1972-EARLY 1973, HA DONG). HE WAS A MEMBER OF A TEAM OF SPECIALISTS THAT WAS TASKED WITH DELIVERING, INSTALLING, AND TROUBLESHOOTING SOVIET AIR DEFENSE MISSILE SYSTEMS IN NORTH VIETNAM.

2. SUMMARY: ALEKSANDROV ADDRESSED A WIDE VARIETY OF TOPICS: HE DESCRIBED THE TWO SEPARATE OCCASIONS HE OBSERVED CAPTURED AMERICAN AIRCREW MEMBERS; EXPLAINED THE ROLE OF THE 10TH DIRECTORATE; PROVIDED INFORMATION ABOUT HIS CHAIN-OF-COMMAND; DISCUSSED HIS PERSONAL AWARENESS OF THE SPECIAL GROUP; AND BRIEFLY DESCRIBED A LOCATION NEAR A LAKE IN HANOI THAT HOUSED FOREIGN MILITARY SPECIALISTS. END SUMMARY

3. THE INTERVIEW

A. CAPTURED AMERICAN AIRCREW MEMBERS: ALEKSANDROV CLAIMED TO HAVE SEEN A CAPTURED AMERICAN PILOT WHO WAS SHOT DOWN, DURING THE DAYTIME OVER CENTRAL HANOI. (JCSD NOTE: THIS OCCURRED DURING HIS SECOND TDY TO NORTH VIETNAM.) HE STATED THAT THE PILOT PARACHUTED TO AN AREA NEAR THE SOVIET EMBASSY. ACCORDING TO ALEKSANDROV, THE SOVIET
