15. TEXT A. IN EARLY JAN 73, SOURCE OBSERVED A PW CAMP RUN BY THE NVA ONE KM NW OF PHUM CHREUKHLOEN, VI: XU.197303 REPEAT XU.197303, 25KM NW OF MIMOT CITY VIC XU.292016 REPEAT XU.292076, IN THE NW AREA OF MIMOT DISTRICT (D), BORDERING KRATIE (P), CB. B. THE CAMP WAS APPROX 200 METERS LONG AND 51 METERS WIDE. THIS FACILITY WAS COMPOSED OF 25 HOUSES BUILT IN TWO PARALLEL ROWS RUNNING THE LENGTH OF THE CAMP. EACH HOUSE WAS APPROX TEN METERS LONG, FIVE METERS WIDE WITH THATCHED ROOFS AND WOODEN WALLS. EACH HOUSE HAD FOUR ROOMS. AROUND THE CAMP WERE TWO ROWS OF WOODEN FENCES AND SPIKE PITS. THE CAMP WAS GUARDED BY NVA TROOPS STATIONED ON BOTH SIDES OF THE CAMP OUTSIDE THE FENCES. THE CAMP GATE WAS MADE OF BAMBOO, FACES EAST AND WAS APPROX 100 METERS FROM THE PATH LEADING TO CHREUKHLOEN. AS THE SOURCE ENTERED THE GATE HE CAUGHT SIGHT OF THREE AMERICANS, TWO CAUCASIANS AND ONE NEGRO. THE THREE PW'S WERE SITTING IN THE FIRST HOUSE.

HAIR: REDDISH
