MOUNTAIN. THE GROUP OF PWS WAS BEING MOVED IN A SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION BY BOTH KHMER AND VIETNAMESE GUARDS (SOURCE DESCRIBED THE VIETNAMESE AS VC).

4. A SERIES OF REPORTS FROM JULY THROUGH SEPTEMBER 1973 PROVIDED INFORMATION ON A PW CAMP LOCATED AT XU 077 352 (KRAT PROVINCE) IN WHICH 15 US PWS WERE BEING DETAINED. THE PWS WERE MOVED TO XU 016 388 ON 10 AUG 1973. ON 15 AUG 1973 THEY WERE TRANSFERRED FROM NVA TO KC CONTROL AND MOVED TO AN UNKNOWN LOCATION.

5. FOUR REPORTS WERE RECEIVED IN 1973 CONCERNING THE EXISTENCE OF AN NVA CONTROLLED PW CAMP LOCATED NEAR HOKOR MOUNTAIN AT US 971 797 (KAMPOT PROVINCE). THE NUMBER OF US/WESTERN PWS DETAINED THERE VARIED FROM 2-6 IN THE DIFFERENT REPORTS.

6. SIX U.S. PWS WERE REPORTEDLY DETAINED IN AN NVA CAMP IN KAMPONG SPEU PROVINCE NEAR THE TOWN OF SRE KHLONG (VT 240 520) FROM JANUARY TO JUNE 1973.

7. TWO U.S. PWS WERE ALLEGEDLY DETAINED IN THE HOUSE OF A VILLAGE LEADER AT ANLUNG THMA (XU 017 388) FROM APRIL THROUGH JUNE 1973.

8. AS OF 6 JANUARY 1974 A COMMUNIST PW CAMP WAS REPORTEDLY LOCATED ABOUT 10 KILOMETERS NORTHEAST OF SVAY RIENG, THE PROVINCIAL CAPITAL. FOUR CAUCASIAN PWS WERE BROUGHT INTO THE CAMP IN MID-DECEMBER 1973. THEY WERE TAKEN FROM THE CAMP ABOUT TWO DAYS LATER.

9. THE MOST RECENT REPORT OF PWS IN CAMBODIA CONCERNED 14 U.S. PWS WHO WERE BEING DETAINED NEAR THE CHUP RUBBER PLANTATION (WU 7430) AS OF 21 MAR 74. ACCORDING TO THE SOURCE, THE CAMP IS LOCATED IN AN AREA WITH VC/NVA AND KHMER COMMUNIST MILITARY REAR BASES. THE SOURCE DID NOT SPECIFY WHICH ELEMENT CONTROLLED THE PW CAMP.

10. ON 24 DEC 1973, A NUMBER OF NVA/PL REPORTEDLY MOVED FROM HUPH KJING (VE 300 730) TO NANTHON (VE 265 964). AT THE TIME OF THE MOVE, ONE US PW WAS MOVED WITH THE GROUP. THERE IS NO CONFIRMATION THAT EITHER OF THESE LOCATIONS IS AN ACTUAL CAMP.

11. A REPORT HAS BEEN RECEIVED CONCERNING A PL/NVA CAMP AT PHA DAKTHONG (VE 430 003) HOLDING NINE US PWS. THESE NINE PWS WERE ALLEGEDLY SENT TO HANOI IN SEPT 1973. NONE OF THIS INFORMATION HAS BEEN CONFIRMED.

12. ANOTHER REPORT STATED THAT A PL/NVA CAMP IS LOCATED AT

PHA KATAG (VE 321 091). ON 20 FEB 1974, FIVE US PWS WERE ENROUTE TO THIS CAMP. FURTHERMORE, A SUBSEQUENT REPORT CLAIMED THAT NINE US PWS WERE MOVED TO THIS SAME CAMP FROM PHA DAKTHONG ON AN UNSPECIFIED DATE. AS IN ALL THE PREVIOUSLY REFERENCED REPORTS, THE INFORMATION IS CURRENTLY UNCONFIRMED.
