

§ 662.1 *Approval of recommendations of industry committee.* The committee's recommendations for the cement industry in Puerto Rico are hereby approved.

§ 662.2 *Wage rate.* Wages at a rate of not less than 40 cents an hour shall be paid under section 6 of the act by every employer to each of his employees in the cement industry in Puerto Rico who is engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce.

§ 662.3 *Posting of notices.* Every employer employing any employees so engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce in the cement industry in Puerto Rico shall post and keep posted in a conspicuous place in each department of his establishment where such employees are working such notices of this part as shall be prescribed from time to time by the Wage and Hour Division of the United States Department of Labor.

§ 662.4 *Definition of the cement industry.* The cement industry in Puerto Rico to which this part shall apply, is hereby defined as follows:

The manufacture of cement.

§ 663.1 *Approval of recommendations of industry committee.* The committee's recommendations for the manufactured coconut industry in Puerto Rico are hereby approved.

§ 663.2 *Wage rate.* Wages at a rate of not less than 28 cents an hour shall be paid under section 6 of the act by every employer to each of his employees in the manufactured coconut industry in Puerto Rico who is engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce.

§ 663.3 *Posting of notices.* Every employer employing any employees so engaged in commerce or in the production of goods for commerce in the manufactured coconut industry in Puerto Rico shall post and keep posted in a conspicuous place in each department of his establishment where such employees are working such notices of this part as shall be prescribed from time to time by the Wage and Hour Division of the United States Department of Labor.

§ 663.4 *Definition of manufactured coconut industry.* The manufactured coconut industry in Puerto Rico to which this part shall apply is hereby defined as follows:

The manufacture of desiccated or prepared coconut.
