## UNITED ARAB EMIRATES

The United Arab Emirates is composed of several sheikhdome, situsted slong the Trucisl Coast of the Arabien-Persian Culf, that have
gathered together and signed the provisional Constitution of July 18,

1/
1971. Among these sheikhdoms, the two most important are: Abu Dhabi
and Dubai, both ruled by hereditary families.

We have not found any provision or judicial precedent concerning the law of sovereign immunity in the United Arab Emirates.
