DISMISSAL

The services of the National Mediation Board were invoked by the Transport Workers Union of America, AFL-CIO on June 12, 1978, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act, as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, the craft or class of Maintenance Control employees, employees of Hughes Airwest.

At the time this application was received, these employees were not represented.


The Board assigned Mediator Walter L. Phipps to investigate.

FINDINGS

The investigation disclosed that no showing has been made by the applicant which would justify a finding that the Maintenance Control employees of Hughes Airwest constitute a separate and distinct craft or class for representation purposes under Section 2, Ninth, of the Railway Labor Act, as amended.

Therefore, the Board finds no basis upon which to further progress the investigation and the application by the Transport Workers Union of America, AFL-CIO of June 12, 1978, is hereby dismissed.
