LIMITATIONS ON AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR SALARIES AND EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FISCAL YEARS 1982, 1983, AND 1984

Pub. L. 97-35, title V, § 510, Aug. 13, 1981, 95 Stat. 443, as amended by Pub. L. 98-312, § 2(a), June 12, 1984, 98 Stat. 233, provided that: "The total amount of appropriations for salaries and expenses of the Department of Education shall not exceed \$308,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 1982, 1983, and 1984, of which—

"(1) \$49,396,000 shall be available for the Office of Civil Rights for each such year; and

"(2) \$12,989,000 shall be available for each of the fiscal years 1982 and 1983, and \$14,961,000 shall be available for fiscal year 1984 for the Office of Inspector General."

[Section 2(b) of Pub. L. 98-312 provided that: "The amendment made by subsection (a) of this section [amending this note] shall take effect October 1, 1983."]

§ 3489. General extension of authorizations

Subject to the limitations contained in subtitle A of this title, there are authorized to be appropriated for fiscal years 1982, 1983, and 1984 such sums as may be necessary to carry out each of the following provisions of law:

(15) title VII of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 [20 U.S.C. 3221 et seq.].

§ 3503. Agency terminations

(a) Specific terminations

On May 4, 1980, the following entities shall terminate:

(A) the Education Division of the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, including the Office of Education;

(B) the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Education of the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare;

(C) the Bureau of Occupational and Adult Education of the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare.
