SYNOPSIS

SIXTH EPISODE

Episode Title - - - - - The Traitor.

Mac is caught in the steel trap, while the tigers prowled about. Mac terrified calls for help. Jimmy still searching for Mac hears the call, and runs to Mac's aid. Jim comes in, sees Mac, and shoots at the tigers. Jim helps release Mac while Mac tells him of his experience in the village.

While the mysterious stranger is away, Edith explores the surrounding jungle.. to await the return of Jim. As she leans against a tree trunk her hand touches a spring which opens the stranger's secret chest, and Edith finds it filled with ammunition and rifles. Mac and Jim come in. They realize that the part found by Mac belonged to Professor Stanton; they decide to go in search of Brandon.

Brandon is on his way to Tomikey; alone he stumbles through the jungle. Ajax the mysterious stranger's ape, sees Brandon and shows his interest when Brandon halts to examine the medal. Unconsciously he shakes the tree and Brandon looks up and starts to run. Ajax runs after him and they struggle. Ajax gets one of the medals from Brandon's hand, and goes back to the stranger's hut.

Olinga's hunters set out for game while the villagers devote the day to prayer. The natives proceed to the shrine room where Marjorie is left to pray. Marjorie is alone in the room when the keeper of the tigers comes to her side and tells her that he knows her secret, and can help her to escape. Marjorie is frightened and doesn't know whether to trust the keeper but decided to take a chance. In her excitement she touches the keeper's arm; the keeper attempts to embrace her. Marjorie screams and tries to free herself but the keeper puts his hand over her mouth. The praying natives outside the temple are salaming and howling, - they get to their feet; their prayer is almost over; the keeper inside struggling with Marjorie, Marjorie bites his hand; he becomes furious. Marjorie starts to run away but the keeper grabs her and draws a knife. He shows her the den of the lions and she screams. Marjorie thinks that the natives will save her, and the keeper must escape. Slowly the keeper forces Marjorie back against the curtained doorway overlooking the arena. Clinging to the curtains, Marjorie steps back; the curtain fastenings give way, - her foot seeks the balcony, she loses her balance, and falls through doorway, pulling curtain with her.

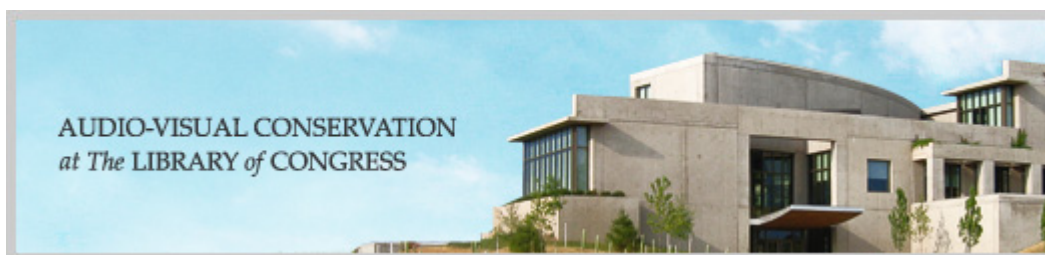
