BANKS CAN SELL TRAVELERS' CHEQUES

Shortly after the outbreak of the war in Europe the American Bankers' Association wired throughout the world stopping the issue of travelers' cheques on foreign countries engaged in war. It will be remembered that financial conditions tightened up so strongly that the American cruiser Tennessee had to take over \$5,000,000 in gold to bring back stranded Americans.

Now, apparently, conditions have cleared up greatly and the following letter received by Malcolm Brock, manager of the First Bank of Cordova, from the Bankers' Trust Co. Wall Street, New York, sheds some light on the present situation:

"Certain conditions have since changed in such a manner as to warrant us in now authorizing you to issue American Bankers' Association travelers' cheques for use in all parts of the world. The writer has just used such cheques in England, France and Switzerland without the slightest friction, and has positive information that they are being taken in other European countries. We do not believe that tourists will care to visit Europe while the war lasts, but there is every possibility that some of your customers having business there may be obliged to do so, and we are certain that the association cheques will give them the best possible service.

"We do not wish to be understood, however, as desiring to encourage travel anywhere in Europe while the present condition of war exists, and we are only authorizing you to issue the cheques in order to place it within your power to accommodate those who are obliged to go to Europe and not with the idea of inducing anyone to make the trip who is not under the necessity of doing so.

"Should any of your customers have to visit any of the European countries, we shall be most pleased to have you give them letters of introduction to us, and we shall be glad to give them such advice and assistance as may be within our power. The writer having just returned from Europe, where he has been continuously since the outbreak of the war, is thoroughly familiar with existing conditions, and will be glad to co-operate with you in every way possible to protect such of your customers as may have to go abroad."
