### \$50.00 FINES !

Oftimes of late I have been wondering how many ladies, children and other fellow pedestrians have been subjected to an undeserved shower of good old Kodiak mud, that was caused by a thoughtless car-driver whizzing by at a reckless rate of speed. How often are people subjected to danger by fast cars rounding blind corners at a speed comparable to a straight wide highway? Little children and elderly persons who are not as agile as others may be, are flirting with gasoline-driven death, when they venture out on the streets of this quiet little town.

Selfishness, rocklessness and the utter lack of regards for others lives and peace of mind constitute the consideration which some drivers demonstrate, in addition to endangering their own lives and property.

For the edification of these few drivers, may I suggest they read the following extract from the Laws of Alaska, Sec.5097 "It shall be unlawful to drive any vehicle on the public highway, outside of incorporated towns....at a higher rate of speed than twenty-five miles per hour...for trucks..than twenty miles per hour, for trucks of one ton or less....and fifteen miles per hour, for trucks over one ton capacity."

Now for the penalties for such violations, Sec.5099 states " Any person driving a motor vehicle at a higher rate of speed than specified, or in any wise violating any of the said provisions....shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction, be fined...not

more than fifty, the first time... not more than one hundred dollars the second offense and...not more than two hundred dollars each subsequent offense and imprisonment not more than thirty days in jail..

Let's not have the Commissioner collect these fines, let's be more considerate of others, let's drive a trifle slower. We'll get just as much done and while doing so, won't jeopardize the comfort and safety of us humble pedestrians.

Bring to a close a ten-day drive for funds for the American Red Cross, specially made for European refugees, Chairman O.A.Torgerson, reported that a total of \$338.15 had been raised, from the groups:-

Town of Kodiak . . . . .	\$ 259.60
Naval Air Base Camp . . . . .	47.50
Marine Corps . . . . .	31.05

Deep appreciation and gratitude is expressed to the many subscribers, particularly to the Marine Corps whose members joined the Red Cross 100%, whose individual incomes are comparatively minute with the average incomes in other groups.

It happens that there is no chapter of the American Red Cross in Kodiak and Governor Gruening wired the Chamber of Commerce to handle the matter, who chose a person most capable of carrying on a successful campaign...Mr. O.M. Torgerson....Our congratulations.

Let's organize a local here and keep some of these Red Cross funds in Kodiak for the benefit of deserving resident cases among our own little community.
