One of the Suspected Nogales Bank Robbers Here.

Last evening Bob Forrest a well known cowboy was brought over from Bisbee by a deputy Sheriff and placed in the county jail on charge of being one of the suspected Nogales Bank robbers.

The arrest was mentioned in the PROSPECTOR Bisbee correspondence yesterday. He was arrested by Deputy Sheriff Johnson and Sheriff Leatherwood of Pima county.

A PROSPECTOR reporter called to interview the prisoner but under the circumstances it was deemed unwise to allow any statement published whatever for the possibility of interfering with the work and plans of the authorities until an opportune time.

It has developed that more than likely the robbers of the Separ post-office and grocery store at Separ, New Mexico and those who attempted the holdup at Nogales are one and the same gang.

The posse trailed the robbers from Nogales to Loebell, and thence to the mountains about 15 miles below the line.

Forrest is a young man, and has a reputation of being a peaceful citizen.
