day and the usual collection of happy
countenances were visible about town.
The scarcity of money in town caused
some inconvenience, but this is a mat-
ter not easily remedied, and one which
we ought to figure on in our financial
calculations. A day's delay in the
coming of a check ought not to be
such a terrible privation as some par-
ties try to make out.

Our delegation of Theopians have
been quite busy today making prepara-
tions for their great effort this evening.

this afternoon to be the better pre-
pared for the evening, while one or

sheep from the effects of post-up ex-
citement. They are all right, however,

of their memorized lines, and we all
