LEADER OF THE GANG.

NEW YORK—William E. Valentine pleaded guilty of forgery in the second degree and abduction, in Kings County court yesterday and was sentenced to ten years imprisonment. Valentine was at the head of a gang of forgers and swindlers whose operations extended all over the United and Canada and involved, it has been stated, as much as \$2,000,000.

DUBIOUS RESIGNATION.

Six of the Bolting Senators Will Not Appear.

NO GOLD CAUSE IN THEIRS

WASHINGTON—The most notable feature of the Republican Senate caucus yesterday, as seen from the outside was the absence of the men who bolted the nomination of McKinley because of the gold standard platform. Those absent on this account were Dulles, Pettigrew, Mantle, Cannon, Squire and Teller. All except Teller were in the city and to attend the caucus.

That their absence was intentional was clearly shown by a letter read soon after the caucus was called to order by Senator Sherman, written by Senator Dubious resigning as secretary of the invited Advisory Committee.

THE MESSAGE IN MEXICO

WASHINGTON.—Power, of Vermont Chairman of the House Committee on Pacific Railroads, said: "Something must be done at once. We will bring up the bill agreed upon by the committee at last session at the earliest possible moment."
