Market News

STOCK MARKET
NEW YORK, Aug. 27. — Stocks today continued to recover from recent acute depression, but fell back when professional sources resumed pressure. The initial rally carried leaders of the oil, equipment, rail and motor divisions 1 to 2 points above yesterday's final quotations. Shippings, sugar and miscellaneous issues also strengthened. The reaction began with further liquidation of United States Rubber common and first preferred, both falling to new low records. The weakness was explained when a statement of the company's operations for the first six months disclosed a deficit of about \$4,855,000. Declines embraced some secondary or low priced rails. New Haven broke nearly two points but saw partial recovery at the heavy close. Sales amounted to 235,000 shares. Bonds were dull and highly irregular, including Liberty issues, which showed mixed gains and recessions.

"Someone in House" At Central Tuesday

Clearing House Report
NEW YORK, Aug. 27. — The actual condition of clearing house banks and trust companies for the week shows that they held \$5,809,580 reserve in excess of legal requirements. This is a decrease of \$11,166,090 from last week.

WEEKLY STATEMENT
NEW YORK, Aug. 27. — Deflation of values in the securities market attained more impressive dimensions this week, when nearly forty different stocks broke into new low territory for the year. The political element figured in the week's developments. Banking and business interests expressed disappointment at failure of congress to formulate definite policies regarding railroads, tariff and taxation before recessing. Rails were least affected and many excellent July statements of earnings were submitted pronounced diminution, however, of the recent demand for bonds and high grade stocks were generally attributed to absence of legislative relief. Increase of production from early August low levels was reported in many basic industries. The notable exception was furnished by the steel and iron trade, where further reduction of price and wage schedules exerted little influence. Additional expansion of federal bank reserves and steady inflow of gold strengthened the impression that the final quarter of the year was likely to bring another reduction of rediscunts and interest rates. Well informed bankers believed, however, that the attitude of the federal reserve board in this connection, hinges on further liquidation of grain and cotton bills at western and southern ports. Discussion of the foreign exchange situation revolved around Germany's additional reparations payment next week. In round figures, these were estimated at \$100,000,000, half of which may be deposited here, the balance going to London.
