

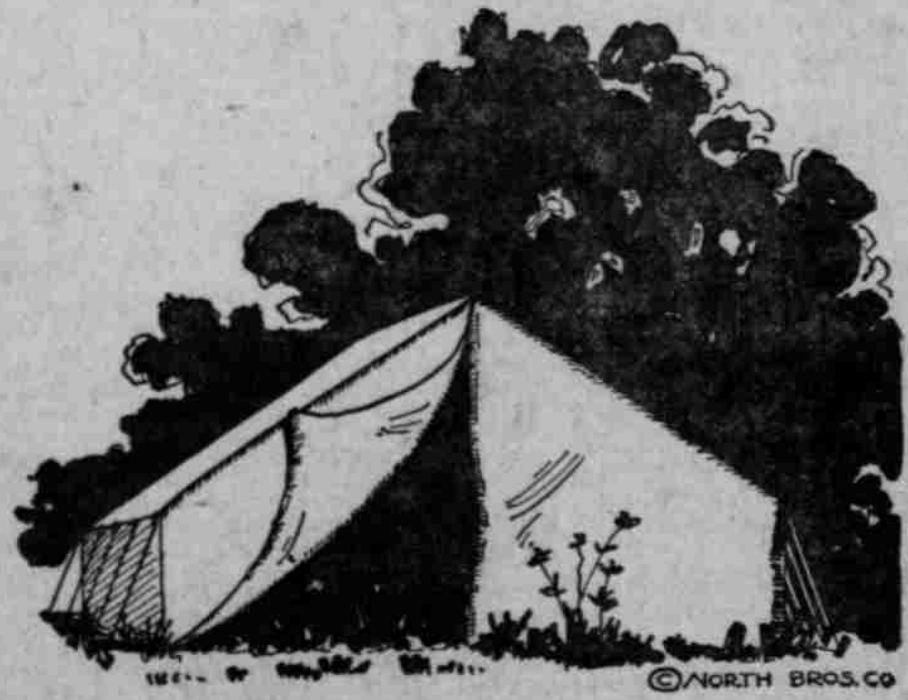
ON CARNIVAL = MESA, Oct. 25-30

OF THE WEEK

THURSDAY—"Mesa Day"—will mark the mid-week period of the festival. The grand ball will be held in the evening of the day, in which the Queen of the Carnival will lead the march. A parade of greater proportions than ever before attempted here will be held during the forenoon. The rodeo opens its gates on this date.

FRIDAY—"Indian Day"—will bring out in full force the aborigines of the Valley. Decked and adorned with paint and feathers, the natives will parade and dance, and in divers ways amuse the delighted thousands. Many restrictions relating to Indian festivals have been removed by the government, and features not permitted for several decades will be permissible on this occasion.

SATURDAY—the last day of the Carnival—will be taken in hand by the Spanish speaking people, of whom there are hundreds in and around Mesa. These folks know the art of merry-making, in music, dance and gorgeous manners of dress, and it is quite certain that they will make the most of the opportunity afforded them during the day and night of Oct. 30.
