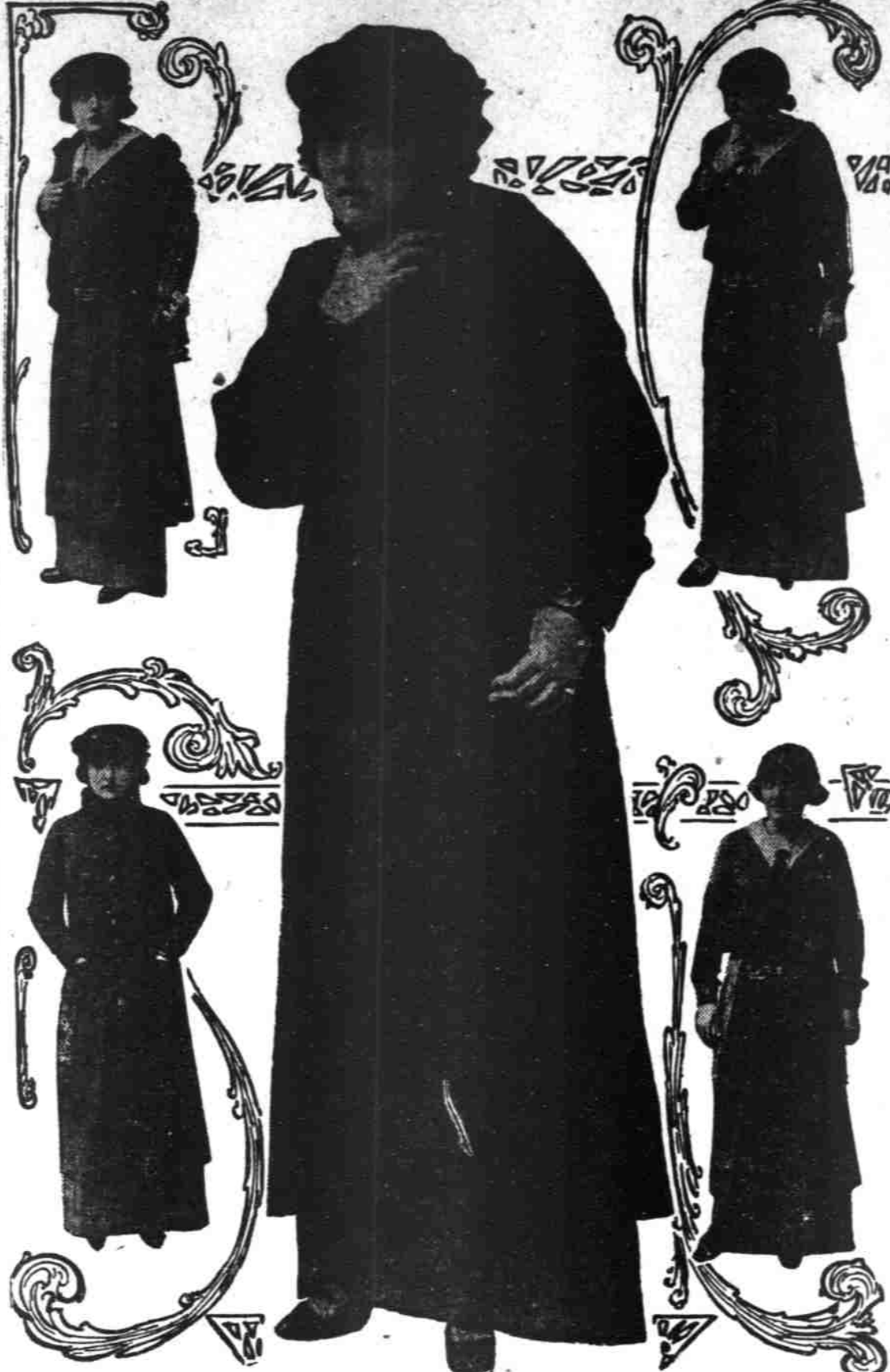

Stuffed Dates—These are a nourishing sweet and with nuts make a satisfactory dessert. Remove the stones from good dates and fill the cavities with minced ginger, blanched almonds, broken walnuts or pecan nuts, plain or with tomato sauce for breakfast, preferably without the sauce.

Another recipe for popcorn balls runs as follows: Pop corn, pick over, and put in a large kettle; there should be five quarts. Put two cups of sugar, one-half cup of oil, one-half cup of salt, and one and one-half cups of water in saucepan. Bring to the boiling point, and let boil without stirring until thermometer registers 260 degrees F.—Woman's Home Companion.
