December 6, 1863—The Monitor Weehawken, One of the Federal Fleet Blockading Charleston, Foundered at Her Anchors in a Gale Off Morris Island, Drowning Thirty of Her Crew—Men in Irons and Sick in Bed Perish in Spite of Efforts to Save Them.

Fifty years ago today the ironclad monitor Weehawken of the Federal fleet blockading Charleston sank in a gale at her anchors off Morris Island, drowning thirty of her crew.
