

Favorites Have Bad Day at New Orleans—Good News for Ring Followers

Arnold Wins Feature Race at New Orleans

Fox's Choice, Outsider, Carries Off Honors in Opening Event—Ablaze Victor

Special Correspondence to The Tribune.—NEW ORLEANS, La., Feb. 24. It was a disastrous day for the followers of favorites at the Jefferson Park track here.

Only one of the seven choices finished first during the afternoon sport, and that was C. A. Applegate's Arnold, a six-year-old bay horse by Peep of Day—Victoria M., who with Butwell won the Hope Haven Handicap about 12:12, beating the 205 2/5 favorite six to five against his chances.

Ticklish finished second and Fort Bliss third. The distance was five and a half furlongs and was run in 1:08 1/8 over a fast track.

In the opening event Fox's Choice, an outsider, carried off the honors, followed by Triumphant and Mietzel May, who finished in the order named. Peggy C. won the second race, with Midas and On High taking down second and third part of the purse.

The third race, a mile and a sixteenth, for three-year-olds and upward, went to Will Do, with a clever ride by Lyke at 8 to 1.

Ablaze, ridden by Stack, was awarded the victory in the fourth race, closely followed by Lady Brummel, the heavily backed favorite, and Kirah.

The Belgian II, who has been knocking at the door lately, caught the judge's eye going under the wire first in the sixth race.

Carpentier Dempsey Big Crowd Sees Match on Market Clever Fighting Yet, Says Descamps In City A. C. Bouts

PARIS, Feb. 24.—That a fight between Georges Carpentier and Jack Dempsey for the heavyweight championship of the world will go to what promoter succeeds in signing Dempsey to a contract, is the gist of an interview with M. Descamps, Carpentier's manager, which will be published to-morrow by "Sporting," a weekly publication dealing with boxing.

"I have given my signature to C. E. Cochran, of London; Theodore Vienne, of Paris; William Fox, of New York; and T. Rickard, as I shall give it to any one who shall bring me sufficient guarantees, always, however, with the provision that Dempsey's signature be obtained," said M. Descamps.

"Mr. Cochran is a personal friend of mine. That is why I gave him the preference after Carpentier's match with Beckett. But up to this date he has been unable to secure Dempsey's signature. Meanwhile I have received a telegram from Jack Kearns, manager of Dempsey, saying that Dempsey had not signed with any one. He also advised me strongly to deal with Tex Rickard and asked me to go to the United States, where he said Kearns and Rickard were awaiting me. Carpentier and I will leave March 13."

Walker Makes Some Changes In Boxing Bill

Age Limit Raised to 18 and Bouts in Armories Permitted—Certain to Pass

ALBANY, Feb. 24.—Senator James J. Walker to-day decided to make several amendments to his boxing bill. One increases the age limit at which boys can fight, from 17 to 18, and another permits boxing exhibitions in state armories.

Senator Walker feels more certain now than ever before that his bill will be passed. The members of both houses are being flooded with letters from constituents, particularly ex-soldiers and sailors, urging favorable action on it.

It is said also that even the reform and religious organizations, which have for years opposed the restoration of legalized public boxing exhibitions, are asking that one of their representatives be placed on the proposed state athletic commission.

Senator Walker said that he had no objection to this, as it is his intention to have only men of the highest standing as members of the commission.
