



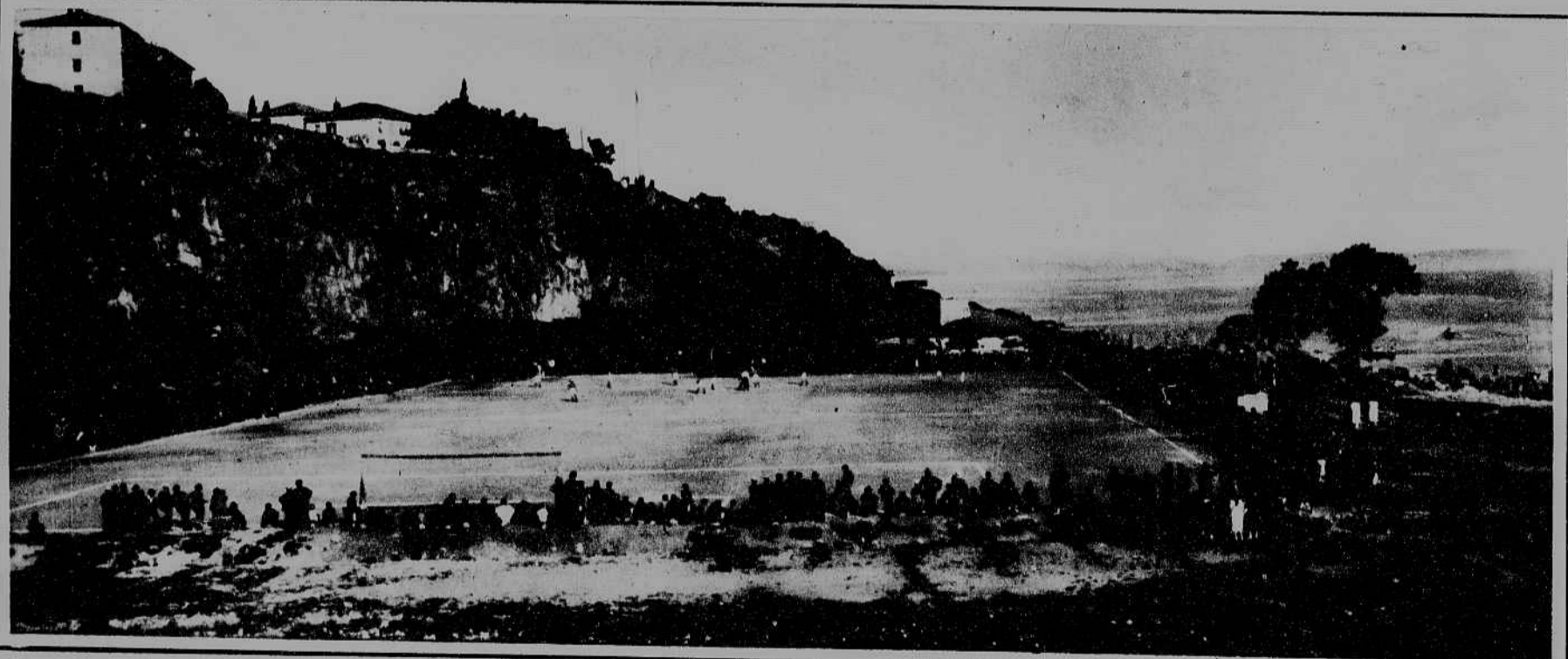

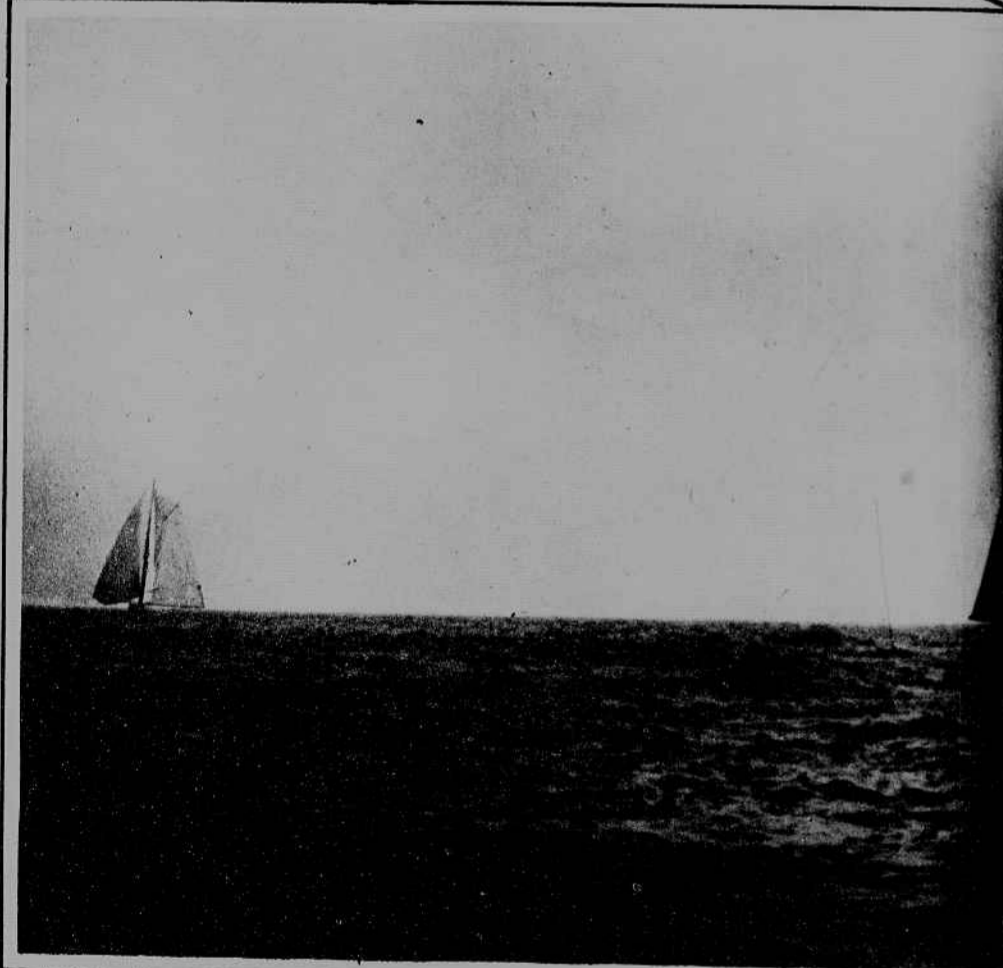

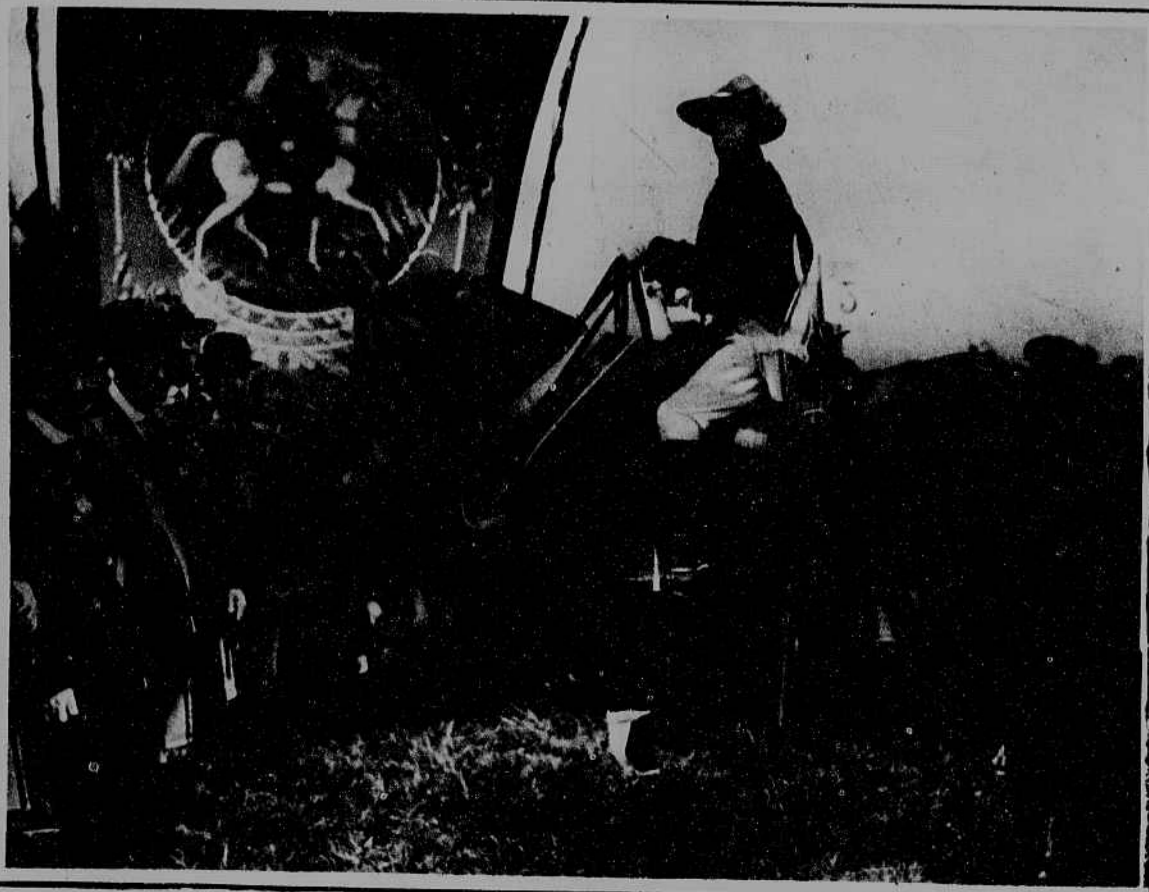

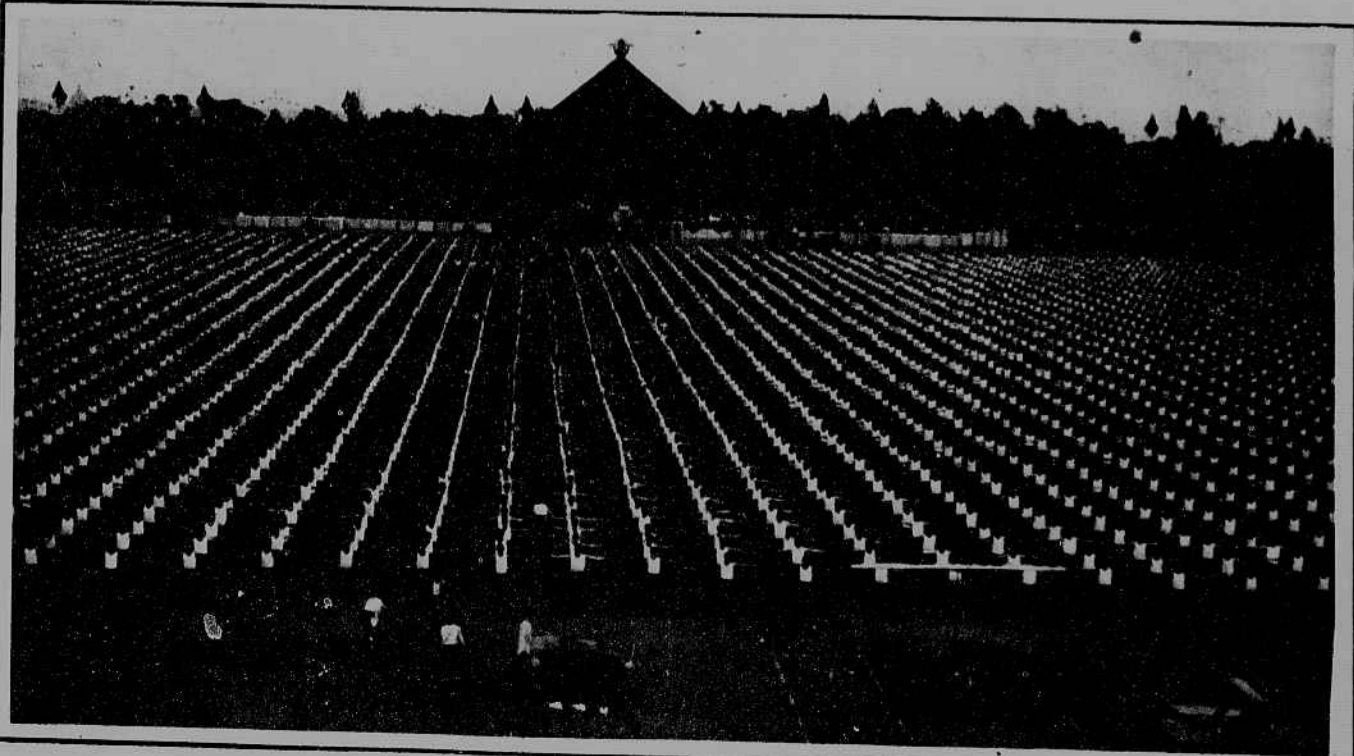
There is a new sort of excitement in Fiume. D'Annunzio's "Arditi," representing one of the crack military organizations of Italy, are here shown in a football match.
