Nine Steamers For Pacific-European Run

The United American Lines Announce a New Service From West Coast Ports to the United Kingdom

To Compete With Others

Company Will Augment the Intercoastal Service by Weekly N. Y. Departures

The establishment of a new fortnightly freight service by steamers of the American-Hawaiian Steamship Company between Pacific coast ports and the principal United Kingdom and continental ports and an extension of the present intercoastal service were announced yesterday by the United American Lines, managing agents of the American-Hawaiian Company.

Nine large carriers, of an aggregate tonnage of 108,000 deadweight, will be engaged in the European service, which will be inaugurated early in October with the departure from the Pacific of the freighter Albatross. Eastbound steamers, it is understood, will proceed from the Panama Canal to the United Kingdom and Europe, touching at Atlantic ports on the return.

May Use Big Motors

Although no announcement was made to this effect, it is understood the company contemplates augmenting the European service with two motorships of 11,000 deadweight tons each, now under construction at the yards of the Merchants Shipbuilding Corporation at Chester, Pa., and that it also plans to add refrigerated ships to afford facilities for the movement of California fruits.

In the Pacific Coast-European Trade
