MARRIAGE ON THE WANE

Vicar General Koch Blames the Youth of Both Sexes.

A Harrisburg Priest Offers an Explanation of the Conditions That Exist—He Says the Young Men Are Impudent and the Girls Too Ambitious—Advice From the Pulpit.

SHAMOKIN, Pa., March 5.—Rev. Father Joseph J. Koch, pastor of St. Edward's Roman Catholic Church, in this city, and vicar general of the Harrisburg diocese, is heartily in accord in many respects with the views of Rev. Father McEnroe, of South Bethlehem, upon the marriage question.

Rev. Father Koch says: "Father McEnroe is right. In the first place marriage is necessary according to God and nature. In St. Edward's Church, which embraces a membership of about 500 families, there are 200 young men and 200 young women who should be wedded."

"To demonstrate how marriage has fallen off in my pastorate, records show that in 1870, when I presided over a congregation of 400 families at Locust Gap, and at this place, there were 48 marriages. Last year in 500 families there were 40 marriages.
