Further Particulars of the Storm on the Coast of Nova Scotia.

HALIFAX, October 12, P. M. The latest telegraphic despatches from Pilot, and letters from the scenes of the late fearful storm.

Between three and four hundred sail of American and provincial fishing and other vessels succeeded in getting safely into the harbor, just before or during the gale.

Here our correspondent gives the names of a large number of vessels which were wrecked, and which vary from previous accounts only in a slight degree.

In the list of vessels ashore, with loss of life, our correspondent says: "A vessel grounded to the westward of the harbor, and immediately after was wrecked."
