General News and Earnings of Various Corporations.

An abstract translation of the official annual report of the Grosz Berliner Strassenbahn (the surface railway system of Berlin).

The report shows that earnings and traffic in the closing months of 1914 were adversely affected because of the war and also because of additional rapid transit and omnibus competition.

Directors were compelled to reduce dividends from 8 per cent in 1913 to 6 per cent in 1914 on a capitalization of \$65,000,000.

Earnings from passenger transportation for the year amounted to \$10,224,480, which compares with \$11,044,541 in 1914.

During 1914 the company carried 426,420,000 passengers, against 456,000,000 in the preceding year.

The operating ratio for 1914 was 103.3 per cent, an increase from 102.6 per cent in 1913.

The company has increased the wages of employees pending settlement of the war, and in case of the operating ratio, the operating ratio behind them is being made to distribution of \$625 is being made to each wife, with an additional \$125 for every child less than fifteen years of age.
