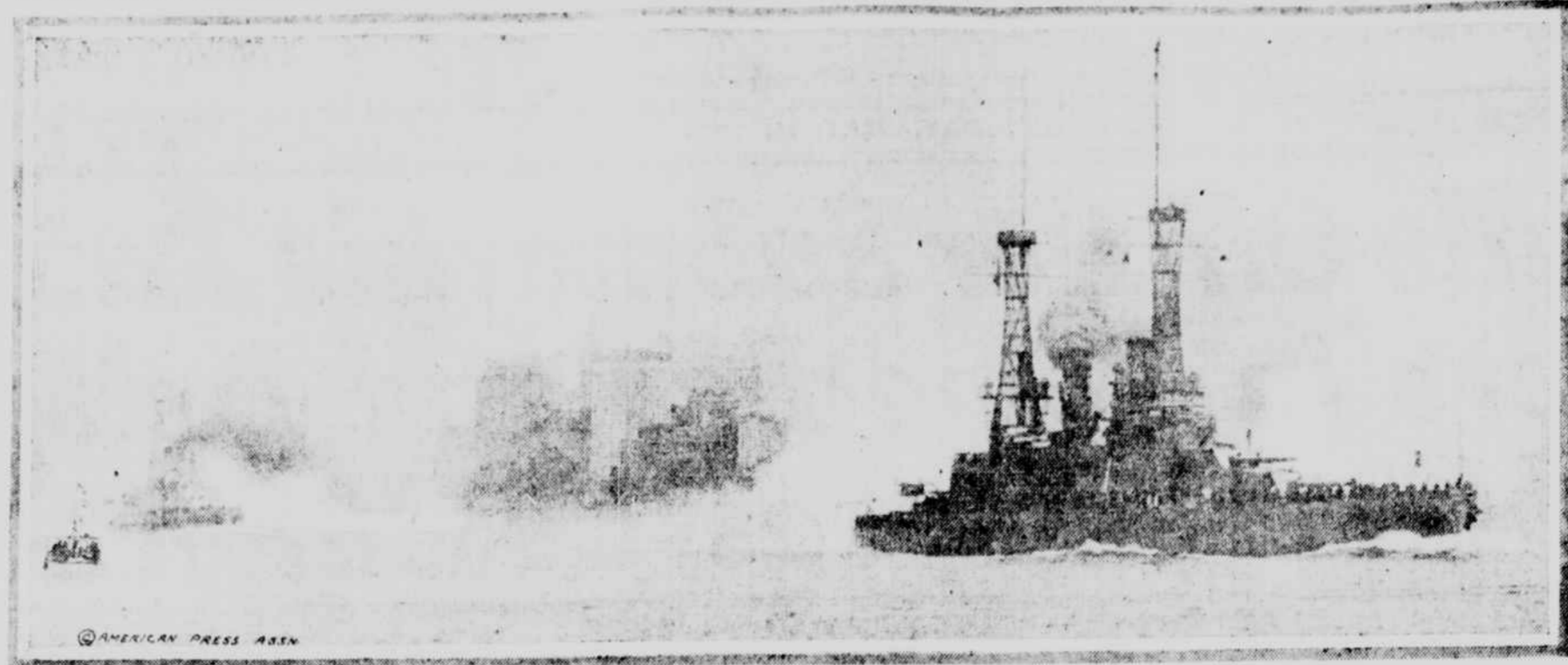


THE BATTLESHIPS NEW HAMPSHIRE AND LOUISIANA (IN THE LINE) OFF THE BATTERY.

Paris, May 18.—Germany's reply to the American note on the sinking of the Lusitania will be sent Thursday, according to 'The Matin' Amsterdam correspondent, who says he is informed it will justify the attack on the steamer on the ground that the submarine commander has affirmed in his report that only one torpedo was fired, which missed her by not more than eight feet.

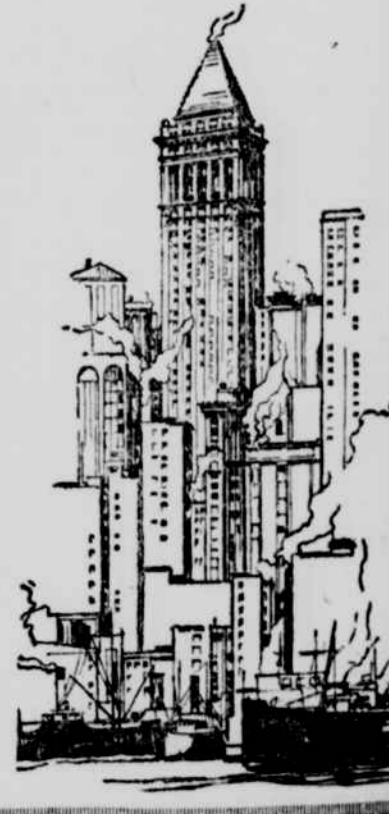
