PARSONS AND PINCHOT ARGUE

Discuss New Constitution from Opposite Sides at Free Synagogue Forum.

The proposed state constitution and its social and industrial aspects were discussed by Herbert Parsons and Amos R. F. Pinchot at the Sunday Evening Forum of the Free Synagogue last night.

Mr. Parsons said that two features adopted by the Constitutional Convention favored labor.

Mr. Pinchot argued against the new constitution, saying that his chief objections were to the budget section, provision for trials by court martial when civil courts were in session and the section which would permit territorial and waterpower grants by the state without compensation.
