Carranzista Troops Move Toward U.S.

Offensive Against Villa, Mexican Officials Explain

Invasion Scouted At Washington

De Facto Soldiers Cannot Do Serious Damage, Army Heads Say

El Paso, Tex., April 5.—De facto troops in the states of Nuevo Leon and Chihuahua have begun a general movement toward the American border, according to highly reliable information received here to-night.

Washington, April 5.—The War Department's comprehensive border reports show no indication of a general southward movement of Mexican troops, and officials have no fear of an attempt at invasion.

Germany Offered Arms to Mexico, Congress is Told

Washington, April 5.—Representative Miller of Minnesota, Republican member of the Foreign Affairs Committee, today declared that an unpublished paragraph of the "Zimmermann note" offered to establish a submarine base in Mexico to supply Mexico with unlimited quantities of arms and ammunition, and send German reservists in the United States to Mexico.

When Representative Miller's quotation was submitted to Secretary Lansing, the latter declared that the Zimmermann instructions "contained nothing of the sort."

New York's pacifists yesterday decided to "help" the German people dethrone the Kaiser.

The appeal says: "We ask that, immediately following the declaration of war, Congress shall send a message direct to the German Reichstag, stating to them that this war against the imperial German government, which now is autocratic and irresponsible, will be averted only by the establishment of a responsible and democratic government in Germany."

18,889 Teutons Get Their First Papers Before Last Day
