NEWS IN BRIEF

Circuit court was adjourned yesterday, after transaction of routine business to be convened this morning at 10 o'clock.

R. M. Merritt, truant officer, spent yesterday at Gulf Point, getting in touch with teachers and pupils, in connection with the enforcement of the school compulsory law. Mr. Merritt may be found at the office of the superintendent of education each afternoon from 3 to 5 o'clock.

Miss Agnes Neva McKinna, welfare worker for Escambia county, met yesterday afternoon with members of the school board, for decision as to mothers' pensions in this county. The matter was carried over until Saturday morning, when the applications will be passed upon in time to present the matter to the county commissioners for their endorsement.

According to the bill which Miss McKinna was instrumental in passing

during the last legislature, and which became a law at that time, any county in Florida may levy as much as 1-2 mill to defray the costs of these pensions. Escambia county commissioners, in their annual budget appropriated \$4,500 for mothers' pensions, which is about half of this amount.

The suit of H. J. Miller and W. B. Cole trading as H. J. Miller Lumber company against Theo Baars for \$5,000.00 damages which was set for yesterday was continued by consent until Dec. 2. L. V. Holsberry is attorney for H. J. Miller Lumber company and John C. Avery is representing Mr. Baars.
