The table and information upon sugar production which was published yesterday in these columns contained a great deal of condensed information upon sugar production which is most valuable. The Bureau of Statistics gives an amount of information which is simply marvellous, and it is disseminated by every paper of standing throughout the United States.

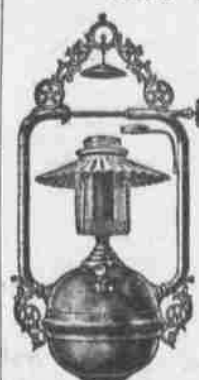
