WASHINGTON, December 22.—The auxiliary cruiser Buffalo will leave San Francisco early in January with a battalion of marines and officers to be stationed at Honolulu.

sealed orders. Neither the State Department nor the Navy Department would give out any information concerning the mission of the Maine nor her destination.

NEW YORK, December 22.—Count Von Bertsch, the Ambassador for Germany to the United States, arrived here yesterday.

CAMEL A NATIVE OF AMERICA.

NEW YORK, December 4.—Camels, hump included, originated in America, and not in Asia or Africa, according to Prof. F. B. Loomis, who has made a study of prehistoric animals. In an address before the Amherst association last night he said that about 3,000,000 years ago the camel roamed about North America. When the beginning of the glacial period brought its covering of ice to this continent, he continued, a few camels went to Asia; others went south, passing the Isthmus of Panama and starting the llama family of South America.

Prof. Loomis showed a series of pictures of skeletons which he and his party had discovered in Wyoming, tracing the development of the camel.
