## A MUSICAL TREAT

Herr Albert Friedenthal's Recitals  
at Y. M. C. A. Hall.

SEASON OF FOUR PERFORMANCES

One of the Greatest Pianists Arrives With a Repertoire of 250 Pieces from Memory.

A veritable treat is provided the music-lovers of Honolulu by the arrival on the Moana yesterday from Australia of Herr Albert Friedenthal, who will inaugurate a series of four piano recitals at the Y. M. C. A. hall on Monday evening.

Herr Friedenthal, who is one of the few "accepted" pianists of the day, was born in Brömberg, a provincial town in the northeast of Germany, in the Province of Posen, in 1862, and is thus 37 years of age. His father being possessed of means, and, having a love of and appreciation for music, resolved to gratify the disposition for the art displayed by his son. So rapid was the progress made by the young student in the local conservatoire that at the age of 14 years he gained a prize

for his playing of Beethoven's C Minor concerto. Removing to Berlin, Herr Friedenthal became a pupil of Theodor Kullak. When little more than 20 years of age he made a concert tour of portions of the United States, Mexico, Venezuela and the West Indies. He then made a successful tour of Italy, Germany and Switzerland, but an advantageous offer and his liking for sport induced him to visit America, both North and South. Then he made his way to China and Japan, afterwards visiting India, Burmah, Java and other places in Asia, and then found himself in Egypt. After a successful tour of a considerable portion of the European Continent, he decided to visit Australia and New Zealand, giving recitals at all of the principal cities of those colonies. In Sydney so highly were these recitals appreciated that as many as fifteen were given in the Town Hall, the largest building in the Southern Hemisphere, it having seating accommodation for an audience of 4,000. This immense building was crowded throughout the season.

The repertoire of Albert Friedenthal is wonderfully extensive and certainly not surpassed by any other living artist. According to a list, recently made, he plays 250 different pieces, all from memory. Among these are a dozen concertos with orchestra accompaniment, just as many sonatas of Beethoven, a large number of fugues and preludes of Bach and the most extensive works of Schumann, Chopin, Brahms, Liszt, etc. On his tours he is generally accompanied by a "Concert Grand" of the famous Bechstein make. This instrument has been specially constructed for Herr Friedenthal, and though it is not the full size of a "Concert Grand" it has all the qualities of the latter.

Herr Friedenthal is not unknown to Honolulu, he having passed through to Japan and China about seven years ago.

Recitals will be given on Monday and Friday, evenings at 8 o'clock and on Wednesday afternoon at 3 o'clock, and again on Monday evening, 23d inst., at 8 o'clock.

Season tickets for the three evening recitals can be obtained for \$2. For Wednesday afternoon recital, 75c. and children 50c.
