## Offers Considered Views on Philippiens.

Insurgents and Friars—Properties of the Church—Talking to the People.

NASHVILLE, Tenn., Oct. 1.—The following private letter has been received from General Joseph Wheeler in the Philippiens:

"SAN RITA, Island of Luzon, September 8, 1899.—I have now seen much of the country and the people in that part of Luzon for about fifteen miles of Manila. In every town there is a magnificent stone church and a convent or monastery. The insurgents have a great antipathy to the priesthood or friars, and they have dismantled many of the churches. The value of the church or monastery of a town seems to be equal in many cases to the value of all the other buildings in the town. The more I talk to the people the more I am convinced that the insurgents are actuated in a measure by a spirit of communism, and in their talks their most serious objection to the church seems to be the fact that the ecclesiastical organization owns so much of the property, and one of Aguinaldo's most earnest demands is that the church property be confiscated.

"There is a general impression that the insurgent army is made up very largely of people without property and that people who have property desire the Americans to control, so that they can have protection and feel that their property is secured to them, but I find that there is also a feeling of apprehension among some of the wealthy that if Americans control and give universal suffrage the power of the wealthy people would be taken away and their hold on property very much impaired. I think that if the wealthy people could be assured that they would be protected in their property rights by the United States it would have a very good effect.

"These friars and priests are charged with all sorts of oppressions and misdemeanors, but it must be remembered that priests and friars are very numerous, and in so large a body there would be every possible phase of character and disposition. Some of them are, no doubt, oppressors of the people, exacting in the collection of rentals from the land, indulge themselves in many ways and lead lives very different from what should characterize the life of a priest. But there are very many good men among them.

"The statement that 70 per cent of the people of Luzon can read and write is a great mistake. It may be true of many, but it is not true of the rural districts, and the percentage of illiteracy in the other islands is much greater than in Luzon. The appearance, mode of life and method of performing work is today very much like it is described in the Bible at the time and even before the Christian era."

### HIS SOCIAL POSITION.

Admiral Dewey Will Be Prominent at Great State Functions.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 21.—Admiral Dewey is expected to take a prominent part in the social festivities of Washington. The avowed purpose of the admiral in securing such a large house as that selected by him was that he might have ample room to accommodate the guests whom he proposed to invite to dinners and other functions during the winter. Official and social residents here are making arrangements for the entertainment of Admiral Dewey, and it is expected President McKinley will request his attendance at various state functions in the White House.

There has been some misapprehension as to Admiral Dewey's position when attending a function participated in by the President and Cabinet, the diplomatic corps and the army and navy, as will be the case at the New Year's reception in the White House. The Vice President will follow the President and after him the six Embassadors. Following the Embassadors, Cabinet Ministers will take rank and then the remaining members of the diplomatic corps. Had the army an officer with the rank of general he would come next, as the War Department was established before the Navy Department, but as Admiral Dewey has greater relative rank than General Miles, who ranks with a senior rear admiral, he will precede that officer and follow the diplomatic corps.

### AMERICA IN CHINA.

Uncle Sam Insists on Recognition in the Far East.

CHICAGO, Oct. 29.—A special to the Times-Herald from Washington says: The United States has demanded from the Government of Russia, Germany and France assurances that in their division of China into zones of political domination or spheres of influence the trade rights of citizens of this country shall be fully respected. These demands are pretty sure to be needed to, and as soon as the necessary correspondence can pass between Washington and the three European capitals it is not doubted that the desired assurance will be given by the Governments named. In fact, a tacit understanding to this effect already exists and little remains to be done but to decide upon the form in which the assurances shall be given. There was some little surprise in diplomatic circles when the demands of this Government were presented through the Embassies here, but no sign of extreme displeasure or of intention to resist, was manifested in any quarter.
