LIBERIA'S COLORED COLONISTS.

A Rose-Hued View of Their Prospects—
Education and Government.
[Washington Cor. Cincinnati Times-Star.]
"There is just as great an anxiety among the colored people to go to Liberia as there ever was," said Mr. Coppinger, the secretary of the African Colonization Society and the Librarian on the United States, as he sat in his room talking to a correspondent.
"How many people has Liberia now, Mr. Coppinger?"
"That is pretty hard to answer, for the boundaries of Liberia are not well defined in the interior. It stretches along the coast some 600 miles and far back into the interior, and includes in its territory a good many of the native tribes there."
"How do these natives conduct themselves towards the Libarians and their habits of civilization?"
"In a manner highly satisfactory. Those who are brought into contact with them see the advantages of civilization and education, and are quite willing and in many cases anxious to take advantage of the opportunity to adopt their customs. Some of the chiefs of the tribes in and near Liberia are encouraging their people to adopt the customs of civilized life, and are sending their children to the schools in Liberia."
"There are schools there?"
"Oh, yes, and good ones. The general system of government there is based upon that of this country, and the schools are good. There are higher institutions of learning, the most important among them being the colleges, over which the Rev. Edward Hlyden presides. He is a native of St. Thomas, of pure negro blood, and the most educated colored man living. He was partly educated in his native island, but came here to complete his education, by finding difficulties and prejudices to encounter, went to Europe, where he attended the best institutions of learning. He is a fine scholar, his orator and an able man."
"How many colored people have been sent from this country to Liberia?"
"About 16,000, most of them natives of this country. Besides those there are some 5,000 natives of Africa who are sent there from captured slave vessels during slaving days. They have all been sent there, and have multiplied, so that there are many more than this number there now, counting the descendants of those sent from here. They have all the institutions of civilization and good government, their congress, cabinet, courts and supreme court, cities, municipal governments, police, business facilities, etc., so that those who go there now do not go to the new and uncomfortable surroundings that characterized the earlier days of Liberia."
The noted Martello Towers.

Travelers on the Irish and English coasts must have noticed a succession of round towers in open and exposed positions that attract a good deal of attention. These are the old towers of Martello, which were erected toward the close of the last century, and were deemed as one of the chief defenses in defeating an invasion by French forces. About a century since the duke of Richmond had returned from the Mediterranean, where he had witnessed the bombardment of a little town on the shores of Corsica by a well-equipped fleet, the cannon were of heavy caliber, but the projectiles could make no impression on a little circular fort built of stone, which stood triumphantly a constant fire. These were not the days of rifled cannon.
The duke made a note of the circumstance, and when a model had to be adopted suggested the fort which had done such service in the siege of Martello. The tower seems now to be forgotten, but the name of it in a corrupted form has, at least, got a foothold in the English language, and may puzzle an etymologist of the future, as indeed it does the traveler, who is told that it is now proposed to destroy these buildings and erect in their place small iron forts in the form of a small's' tower, which will be a little cut target to the best rifled cannon shots at even a short range.
