Lieut. Harbor and Master Schiette detailed to search for the survivors of the lost Jeannette, sailed from New York on the 4th inst.

London, Feb. 6th.—The Times says the Queen's speech dwells on the disappearance of many of the causes of anxiety in Europe, Asia, and Africa of the Eastern question. Only one point will be referred to, namely, the peaceful transfer of Thessaly. The speech will congratulate the country upon the restoration of peace in Afghanistan, and in the Transvaal, and will refer to the Poradic troubles in Basutoland. The Queen will also announce the approaching marriage of the Duke of Albany.
