NEW YORK, N. Y., Aug. 12.—Frustrated by his campaign of nearly a year to make Wilson the Democratic Presidential nominee, and attacked with intestinal indigestion, Chairman William F. McCombs of the Democratic National committee was compelled today to take to his bed. Physicians who attended him at the Royalton insisted that he forget all about his duties for a week at least.
