**WEEK'S BUSINESS SHOWS DECLINE**  
Oahu slid back half a point in recess sales of 155 shares in six unequal lots. Other sales reported today were 25 and 15 Pioneer unchanged at 31 and 5 Pineapple unchanged at 44.  
Honokaa held its own on the board at 8.25 for 10 shares. Olaa dropped a quarter point to 5.75 for 100 shares, and lost an additional eighth in sales of 20 and 10 shares at 5.625.  
For the six days ended at noon today the total business on the exchange amounted to \$120,061.12 1/2 as compared with \$123,727.50 for the same period of last week, or a decrease of \$3666.37 1/2. As there was a total of bond sales of \$43,000 this week against one of \$30,000 last week, or an increase of \$13,000 in bonds, the decline in stock transactions was \$10,666.37 1/2.

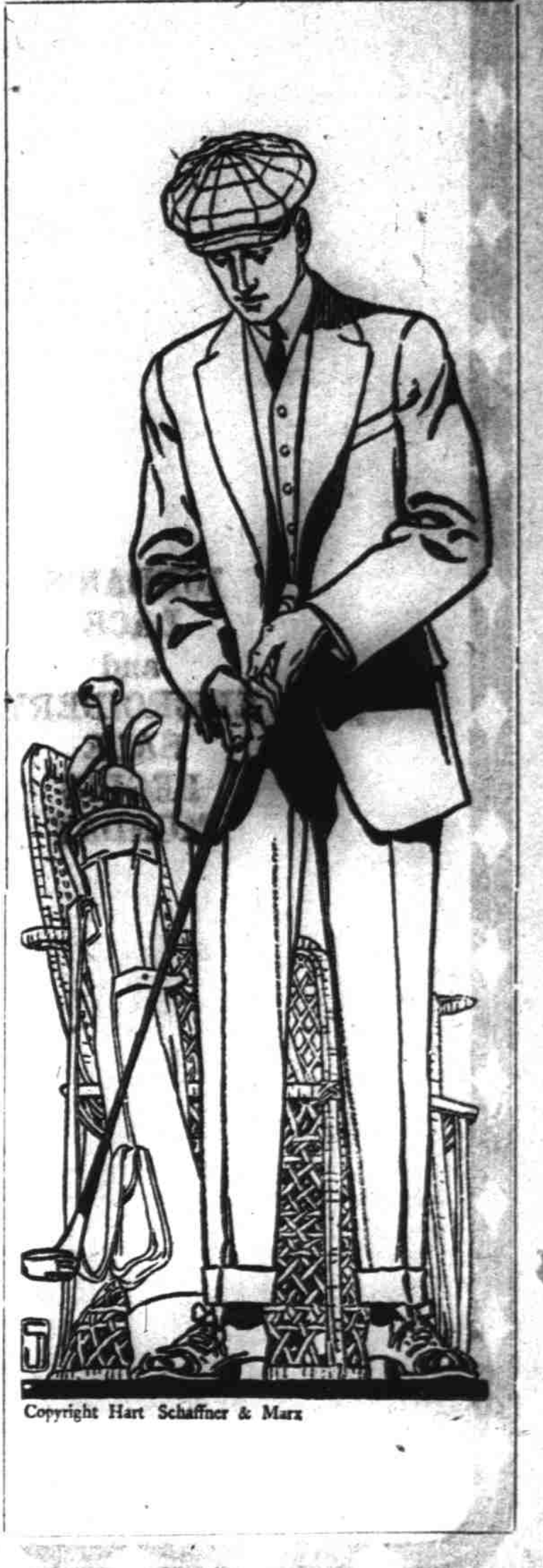
