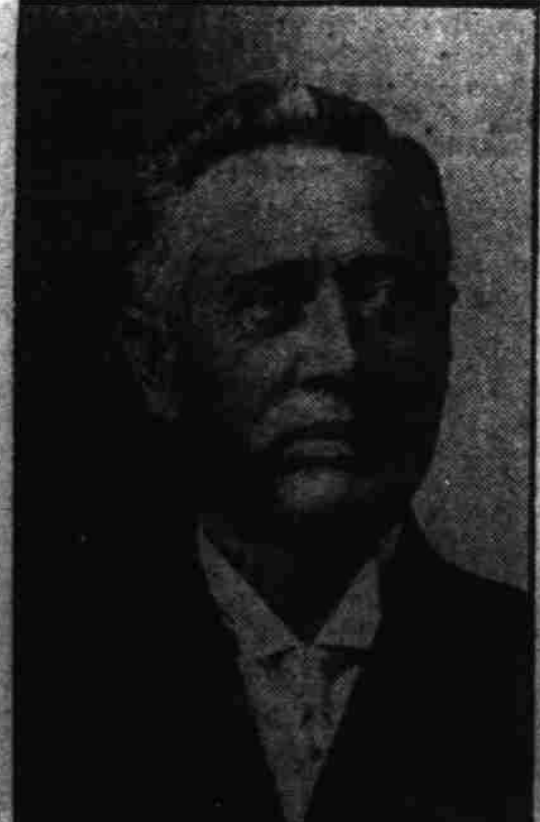

expense of governmental work, at the same time making a large number of much-needed improvements.

Figures compiled today show that the new board of supervisors will have nearly \$50,000 a month to spend for the good of the city and county of Honolulu if it uses up all the funds that will be available. In round figures, the total is \$595,402 per annum. The present board has been using all the funds it was entitled to take, but that has been \$45,000 less than the new board will have at its disposal, the difference being due to the higher assessed valuation of property on Oahu.

While the tax for the next year cannot be reduced, the new city fathers, if they determine to keep their campaign pledge, may cut actual expense sufficiently under the available amount, \$595,502, to warrant a reduction in the tax rate the following year at the same time having the surplus left from the first year to fall back upon.

This total, however, does not include the moneys to be received in fines in the police and circuit courts, from business and liquor licenses and other minor sources, which should boost the grand total materially toward the three-quarter of a million dollar mark.

The available fund, not including the moneys from the sources just mentioned, is itemized as follows:

For current expenses, one-half of one percent tax on the real and personal property valuation	\$403,427
For permanent improvements, one-sixth of one percent on the net real and personal property valuation	134,475
For maintenance of public school buildings and grounds	17,500
Road and poll tax	40,000
Total	595,402

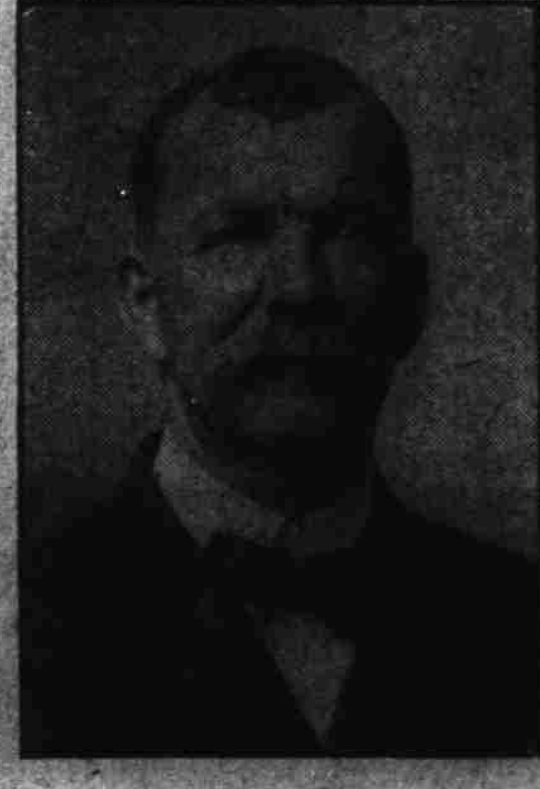

for hospital patients, for during two of the engagements of the recent "war" the post would have been under fire. It is a great source of gratification to department officers that Hawaii now has the actual management of its own medical department, and, with the recent additions to the Shafter hospital, the best results are looked for.

Major Kennedy, now senior medical officer of the department, will continue to command the Fort Shafter hospital, although on the arrival of Lieutenant Colonel H. I. Raymond, M. C., he will cease to be the ranking surgeon of the department. Colonel Raymond, however, will be stationed at Schofield Barracks, where Major De Witt is now in command of the sanitary troops.

SUPERVISORS ARE APPOINTED

To enable the supervisors on the other islands to take up their work immediately Governor Frear has hastened the appointment of men to fill the vacancies left by the pre-election resignations, and this morning making reappointment and two new ones.

Alfred Menefoglio is made a member of the board of supervisors on Kauai and a member of the Kanai loan fund commission, succeeding J. Lota, who has been elected to the legislature. Menefoglio has been elected to the board of supervisors for the ensuing term, so he will merely step into his duties two months earlier than ordinarily would have been the case.

On Hawaii the Governor has reappointed Henry P. Beckler, supervisor, to fill out his own term, and Henry J. Lyman, who has been elected supervisor, is appointed to fill out the uncompleted term of Norman Lyman, who has just been elected to the legislature.

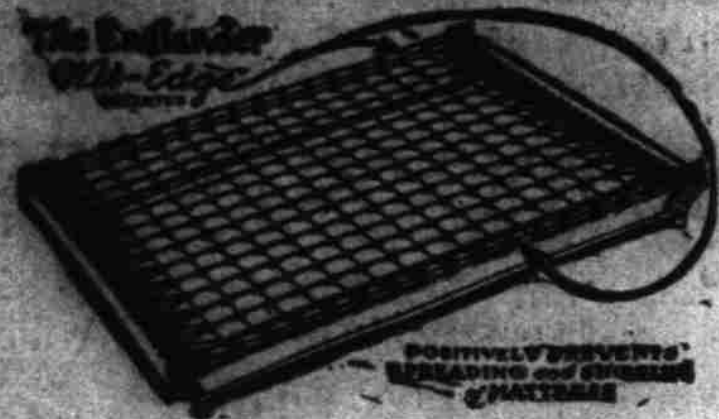
