The third big football game of the season will take place on Alexander field tomorrow afternoon at three o'clock, when the McKillops' High School eleven will try their luck against the town team.

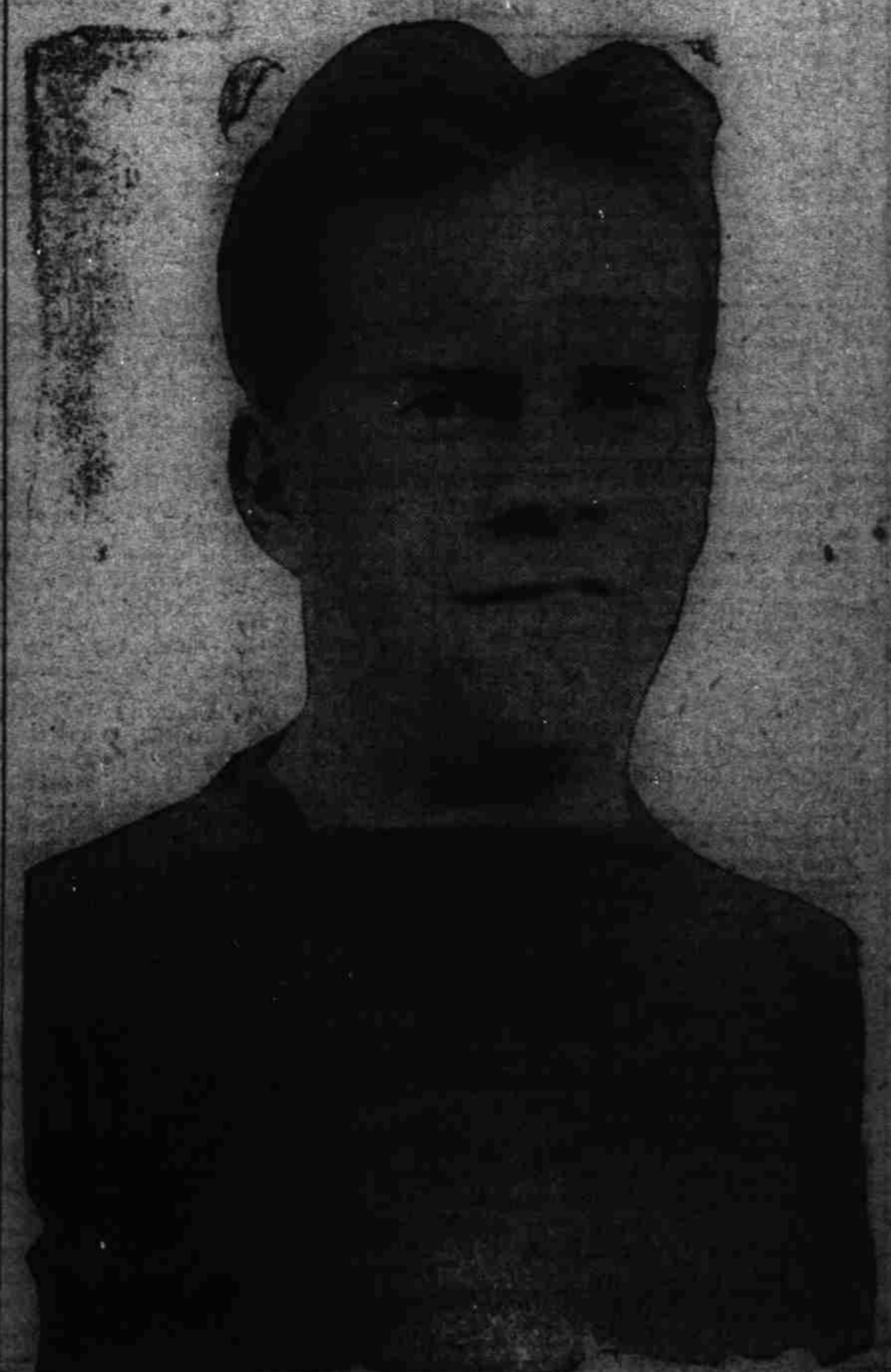
M'Kinley Needs More Cheering
