for a touchdown. C. Hoogs tried for goal but failed, leaving the score six to nothing in favor of the Townies. The Highs kicked off to the Townies and the ball was received by Sumner on the fifteen-yard line. Tucking the oval under his arm, he ran the remaining length of the field for a touchdown in ten seconds after he had received the ball. Goal was kicked by C. Hoogs, making the score thirteen to nothing in the Townies' favor. The Highs once more kicked to the Townies, Hoogs receiving the ball on the thirty-yard line and advancing it eight yards. On the first down Hoogs took the oval around left end for a gain of four yards and on the second Rosa went through left tackle for a gain of five yards. The Townies were penalized five yards for playing offside at the period and on the next down a pass was received by C. Hoogs who advanced the ball two yards. On the next down Sumner made a gain of two yards and the Highs were penalized five yards for playing offside. First down again; Hoogs was sent through for a gain of five yards and on the second down Sumner made two yards more. A pass was then made by Aldrich, the ball being received by Melin, of the Highs. On the High's first down Stone ran with the ball and made a gain of four yards, but the Highs were penalized fifteen yards for holding. On the second down Cassidy went through left guard for a gain of four yards and on the third was held down by the Townies for no gain. On the fourth Cassidy punted and the ball was received by Aldrich on the Townies' thirty-five yard line, he advancing the ball six yards before being tackled. On the first down, Hoogs took the pigskin, but was held by the Highs for no gain. The Highs were penalized five yards for playing offside, and on the next down Hoogs carried the ball through right tackle for a gain of three yards. The whistle announcing the end of the first quarter blew as the teams were lining up. Townies, 13. Highs, 0.

**Second Quarter.**  
The ball went into play in possession of the Townies on their forty-yard line, second down. Aldrich attempted to carry the ball for a gain but was held back by the Highs. On the third down, he made a pass which was received by W. Hoogs who ran fifty-five yards for a touchdown but he went down once but rolled over on his feet and outdistanced the High men who were hot on his heels. A pretty goal was kicked by C. Hoogs on the Townies' side. The Highs kicked off to the Townies and the ball was received by Patz who made a good run of eighteen yards before being tackled. On the Townies' first down, no gain was made, but on the second, Aldrich went through center for a gain of six yards and then Sumner went through the same place on the third for a gain of two more. A pass was then tried and proved incomplete, and the ball went over. On the High's first, Brash made about two feet through left tackle and then Stone took the oval but made no gain. The Townies were penalized five yards for offside playing at this juncture. Stone again took the oval for no gain, and on the next down Brash succeeded in making two yards. A pass was then made which proved to be incomplete, and on the next a punt by Cassidy was blocked by Farrow and the ball was recovered by W. Hoogs, who advanced it four yards. Hoogs, of the Highs, went out of the game at this stage, his place being taken by "Fats" Hart. On the first down, Rosa took the ball around left end for a gain of one yard, and the Townies were penalized fifteen yards for holding. On the second down a fumble was made by the Townies but the ball was recovered by Aldrich with no gain for the down. Aldrich then made a pass and the ball was received by W. Hoogs who made a gain of twenty yards. On the first down C. Hoogs punted and the ball was received by Brash on the High's twelve-yard line. On the High's first down Brash made a gain of six yards through right tackle and on the second a pass proved completed which netted the Highs a gain of seven yards. The Highs then worked their new play and Cassidy went through the Townie line for a gain of eight yards. The same play was repeated on the second down and this time the Townies broke it up with no gain for the Highs. Brash was then called and took the leather through left tackle for a gain of five yards, and on the first down Cassidy was held down for no gain. On the second, Cassidy attempted a run through left tackle but he was pushed back for the loss of a yard. Cassidy then went through center for a yard gain, but was kept from making more by the good work of Barnhart. The quarter ended at this stage of the game with the score still twenty to nothing in favor of the Townies. Fifteen minutes rest was the time allotted between the halves.

**Third Quarter.**  
Captain Dyson went out of the game and his place at center was taken by Silva. The Highs kicked off to the Townies and the ball was received by Moore on the fifteen yard line who advanced it fifteen yards. On the first down Hoogs made a gain of three yards around left end and on the second Rosa skirted right end for a gain of eight yards more. On the first down Sumner went through right guard for a gain of six yards and then, on the second, he went through center for another gain of four yards. First again; Aldrich took the ball and ran through left tackle for ten yards, thus bringing around another first down. Hoogs fumbled the ball

from a bad pass from center, but the ball was recovered by Hart, who ture off a good ten yards before he was stopped. On the first down Rosa took the ball through for a gain of three yards and was stopped from gaining further by Brash. On the second down Hoogs made eight yards more around left end, and on the first down Hoogs made no gain. On the next downdown Sumner got in two yards and the Highs were penalized five yards for playing offside. On the first down Aldrich carried the ball around right end for a gain of three yards and Rosa followed him up on the second with four yards more, and on the third Hoogs made a fumble and the ball was recovered by the Town team. On the fourth one yard was made by Aldrich and the ball went over. Brash took the ball through left guard for a gain of five yards, and on the second he broke away from the Townies and made a sensational run of twenty-five yards before he was finally stopped. On the first down Stone was pushed back for the loss of a yard and then En Choy was sent through for a gain of six yards. Jiro, playing end, received a bad cut over the eye at this stage of the game and went out, his place being taken by Holt. On the fourth down Cassidy made a gain and the Townies were penalized five yards for playing off side. On the first down Cassidy made a gain of five yards and on the second added another yard around left end. On the third Brash made another good gain of fifteen yards and on the first, En Choy was held back for no gain. On the second Cassidy made a yard and on the third made no gain. He ran again with the ball on the fourth and only made two yards and the ball went over. On the Town's first, Rosa took the sphere through center for a gain of two yards and on the second Aldrich made a pass which proved to be incomplete. On the third a punt was made by C. Hoogs and the ball was received by Melin just as the whistle blew announcing the close of the third quarter.

**Fourth Quarter.**  
Jones took center for the Townies. Chillingworth went in for Rosa at left half, and Bellentyne went in for F. Hoogs at right half. On the High's first down Brash took the ball through left tackle for a gain of three yards and the Highs were penalized five yards for playing offside. On the second down a pass was made which was received by Melin who ran fifteen yards before he was tackled. On the first down Jones, center for the Townies, broke through the line and tackled Stone before he had a chance to pass the ball to the High backs. The Highs then punted the ball, it being received by Chillingworth, who fumbled it with the result that it was pounced upon by the Highs, netting them a good eighteen yards. On the first down a good pass was made which was received by Stone, who made a gain of seven yards. On the second Brash reeled off three yards more and brought the ball to within fifteen yards of the Townies' goal line. On the third down Jones again got through the line and tackled Stone, pushing him back for a small loss. Jones repeated the trick on the fourth down and the ball went over. The Townies punted out and the ball was received by Hoogs who made a small gain. On the first down En Choy made a yard and on the second Brash made another. The Highs were now within thirty-five yards of the Townies' goal and they tried a pass which proved to be incomplete. On the fourth down a good attempt to kick a field goal was made by Brash, but the ball swerved to one side and no score was made. The ball went over and the Highs chose aerismania. On the first down Chillingworth took the oval and made a splendid run of thirty-five yards around left end. On the next down the ball was given to Bellentyne who broke away from the Highs and ran forty yards for a touchdown. Hoogs kicked goal, making the score twenty-seven to nothing in favor of the Townies. The Highs kicked to the Townies and the ball was received by Sumner on the twenty yard line, who advanced the pigskin fifteen yards. On the first down Chillingworth was pushed back for a loss of two yards and a pass was made on the next which was received by C. Hoogs, making a gain of fifteen yards. Another pass was then tried which proved incomplete and on the second Aldrich took the ball through right guard for a gain of eight yards. Another pass proved to be incomplete and on the fourth down an attempt was made to kick a place, but it failed. At this juncture the game came to a close with the score standing twenty-seven to nothing.
