William T. Haines, whose picture is shown above, is the man largely responsible for Maine's return to the Republican ranks at the election a few days ago. His vigorous and aggressive personality won thousands of votes during his campaign against the Democratic governor, Plaisted, and he was easily elected governor to succeed him. Not only this, but a Republican legislature, assuring the naming of a G. O. P. senator, and a set of Republican congressmen were also elected. The result is that it looks like a Taft or Roosevelt victory in Maine next November.
